NOTICE: Pursuant to federal procurement standards as identified in 45 CFR Part 75 and 2 CFR 200, as applicable, bids for consideration to provide the services detailed in the scope of services listed below, shall be received by Olga Golik, Citrus Health Network, at olgag@citrushealth.org, until **3:00 pm on Friday, January 30, 2026**. The subject line of the email submittals shall state **"Citrus Health Site Renovations ITB# 2026-01"**. As described below, emailed proposals (bids) must be submitted on or before the due date and time. The Invitation to Bid Application is available electronically online at citrushealth.org/procurements starting January 9, 2026.

There will be a mandatory Pre-Bid meeting on January 16, 2026 at 11:30am at the site, 4175 W. 20th Ave., Hialeah, and proceeding immediately after to the second site, 551 W. 51st Pl., Hialeah, FL 33012. The bid form will be emailed to participants of the Pre-Bid meeting after the meeting. The deadline to submit questions, requests for information & clarifications is midnight, January 20, 2026. Responses to questions expected to be provided by January 23, 2026.

All submittals are due and must be submitted on or before Friday, January 30, 2026 at 3:00pm. Late submittals shall **not** be accepted or considered.

Respondents are to deliver **an email** submittal of statements of qualifications and experience and other pertinent information for consideration, as indicated in this Invitation to Bid. The bid form must be emailed in excel format.

Citrus Health Network (CHN) reserves the right to accept any bid deemed to be in the best interest of CHN or to waive any informality in any submittal. CHN may reject any or all bids and re-advertise.

PROJECT OVERVIEW

Citrus Health Network is seeking bids from qualified licensed general contractors to perform certain work at two of its sites located at: Citrus Main Health Center, 4175 W. 20th Ave., Hialeah, 33012, and Citrus Maternal and Child Health Center, 551 W. 51st Pl., Hialeah, FL 33012, respectively. The work will include, as more particularly described in the Scope of Work attached to the ITB, connection and installation of a generator at each site. Citrus will select one bidder to perform all Work at both sites. Bidders must read the Scope of Work and plan documents carefully.

The project and the work to be performed under this ITB is funded by 2023 Capital Assistance for Hurricane Response and Recovery Efforts (CARE) funding of the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS), for the purpose of increasing Citrus Health's capacity and capability to prepare for, respond to and/or recover from future emergencies and/or disasters, as part of an award totaling \$589,000 with 0% of the award financed with non-governmental sources. All work must comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act and local codes, and all other laws and requirements described in the ITB.
