About VCHA

The vision of the Virginia Community Healthcare Association (VCHA) is for the Commonwealth of Virginia to have the healthiest population in America.

VCHA, established in 1980, is a non-profit membership organization that serves as the primary care association for Virginia's thirty community health centers and look-alike health centers. Membership in VCHA is open to all Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs) and Federally Qualified Health Center Look-Alikes operating delivery sites in Virginia.

VCHA supports health centers in their mission to provide access to health care regardless of geographic location or ability to pay. VCHA works with health centers, community leaders, and partners to enhance access to affordable, high-quality health care and to find solutions for expanding access to care in areas that need it most.

VCHA is an integral part of Virginia's Health Safety Net, which includes Virginia's Community Health Centers (CHCs), nonprofit rural health clinics, community-based providers of primary care, and health departments providing primary care services, and other similar organizations.

Project Overview

This RFP aims to provide potential Contractors with the information required to prepare a proposal for consideration by VCHA on behalf of FQHCs to determine a single source awardee capable of best fulfilling the laboratory services needs for VCHA and member health centers.

As a recipient of Federal funds under Section 330 of the Public Health Services Act, VCHA and FQHCs are required to adhere to all applicable federal procurement rules and regulations and other program expectations of the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) Cooperative Agreements and FQHCs programs. Respondents are encouraged to become familiar with any special procurement rules that may affect their response to this RFP.

In addition, please note the following administrative procedures and guidelines for preparing a proposal:

- a) Nothing in this RFP shall constitute an offer or invitation to contract.
- b) VCHA will treat all proposal information as confidential before a contract is awarded, and it will not be disclosed except as required by law or court order.
- c) The issuance of this document and the receipt of information in response to this document will not cause the VCHA to incur any liability or obligation, financial or otherwise, to any Contractor. VCHA assumes no obligation to reimburse or in any way compensate a Contractor for expenses incurred in connection with its proposal.
- d) VCHA does not discriminate against faith-based organizations or a Contractor because of race, religion, color, sex, national origin, age, disability, or any other basis prohibited by state and Federal law relating to discrimination in employment.

All requests for proposal shall be returned with requested information in each of the outlined contract specifications listed below, beginning with the Bidders Information Sheet (**Attachment #1**).

Scope of Work

- **1.** <u>Laboratory Needs:</u> VCHA members utilize a wide variety of laboratory services. For this reason, services must be of a comprehensive scope and processed in a timely manner. Please refer to **Attachment #2** for a listing of the most frequently utilized laboratory services.
- 2. <u>Duration:</u> The contract shall be for a period of three (3) years, commencing on or about September 1, 2023, and continuing until August 30, 2026, unless terminated before that date. A contract may be terminated if 50% of the participating VCHA members under the contract request termination for lack of adequate service or upon mutual agreement between VCHA and Contractor.
- **Pricing:** Prices must remain at the same level during the contract period. Pricing should be proposed as follows:
 - a. A special net fee should be proposed for the tests listed in Attachment #2.
 - b. All other testing should be bid at a percentage discount from current fee schedules.

A listing of all prices conducted for each test provided by the laboratory before discount, special net prices, and net prices after discounts should be provided with the bid response.

In addition, a special note should be made regarding any special fees for cytology and tissues to which the percentage discount may not apply. If a percentage discount may not apply, the lab must provide a specific price for all cytology and tissues.

- **4.** <u>Individual Prices to Centers</u>: Contractor must agree to provide special pricing on up to five tests to centers that request and need special profiles unique to those centers. Pricing must be at least at the percentage discount bid for other testing.
- **5. Contractor Capability:** Contractors must meet the following criteria:
 - a. Must be participating with all Virginia Medicaid and Medicare Managed Care Organizations.
 - b. Must ensure daily pick-up of lab samples, Monday through Friday.
 - c. Must return lab reports, by electronic transfer, fax or email, within forty-eight hours of pick-up or provide a listing of lab reports for which this requirement cannot be
 - d. Must process billing information back to the applicable health center within 30 days.

6. Billing:

- a. Laboratory Contractor must agree to accept Medicaid and Medicare patients and to bill those third parties directly. Contractor must agree to bill the center directly for all remaining patients. Contractor must agree that patients will not be billed directly unless such billing is requested by a center in writing.
- b. Where a third party is billed for laboratory services, Laboratory Contractor will apply its sliding fee scale (SFDS) to the patient's responsibility. The FQHC will be responsible for providing Laboratory Contractor with the information on which the patient's sliding fee discount is based within 15 days of the date of service to facilitate the Laboratory Contractor's determination of patient eligibility for the Laboratory Contractor sliding fee discount. The patient discount will be automatically applied, and the patient will not be responsible for contacting the health center or Laboratory Contractor to have this discount applied to the patient's responsibility. Laboratory Contractor will make available and apply their sliding fee discount so that health centers may compare it to their discount percentage to the amount owed after contractual allowances based on their third party contracts.
- c. Laboratory Contractor will acknowledge in their response the understanding that the sliding fee discount requirement is an element of the HRSA Compliance Manual that requires that patients who are eligible for sliding fee discounts and have third-party coverage are charged no more for any out-of-pocket costs that they would have paid under the applicable SFDS discount pay class. Such discounts are subject to potential legal and contractual restrictions.

7. Accreditation:

Contractor must submit the following at the time of bid:

- a. U.S. Center for Disease Control identification number
- b. Medicare license number
- c. Medicaid license number
- d. CLIA number

Contractor must also successfully participate in The College of American Pathologists Comprehensive Survey Program. In addition, Contractor must provide assurances that a minimum of 95% of all services shall be rendered directly by Contractor and shall be supervised directly by persons fully qualified in the relevant profession, trade, or field and hold all licenses required by law.

- **8.** Routine Testing: Contractor must provide turnaround time schedules with a test and where test is performed. All routine test results shall be reported within 24 hours, with the following exceptions:
 - a. A panic Value Results@ results must be reported to the center on a stat basis;
 - b. A Multi-day analysis@ results must be reported within 24 hours of completion;
 - c. Define A Turn Around Time@ for specialized tests to other laboratories. Lab must note any test that will take longer than one week; and
 - d. Lab must state the turnaround time for each region for pap smears.

Stat Testing: When requested, Contractor must agree to arrange for stat testing for up to 2% of the total test volume referred by the center to all local laboratories. Such stat testing must be paid for by Contractor and billed to the center at the contract rate. Contractor must also be able to provide contract information on those local laboratories by listing.

- **9.** <u>Courier Service</u>: Contractor must agree to provide courier service at no extra cost. All centers that will be provided availability for courier pick-up should be identified by Contractor in RFP response within **Attachment #4** of the response:
 - Monday thru Friday, except on center holidays (holidays may vary);
 - At least once per day; and
 - No earlier than 3 PM each day or at other times agreed to be the center in writing.
- **10.** <u>Laboratory Personnel Training</u>: Contractor must agree that prior to the start day of the contract that it will:
 - Supply each participating center site with two sets of manuals, as well as an online portal access point, listing all tests available, turnaround time, method, normal range, specimen requirements, instructions and cost; and
 - Visit each center and instruct the personnel on properly handling specimens and billing requirements. Upon staffing changes of staff handling specimens and/or billing, Contractor will supply additional training as requested by a particular center, either in person or virtually.
- **11.** <u>Consultation:</u> Contractor must agree to provide telephone consultation service at no additional charge, 24 hours per day, seven days per week.
- **Continuing Education:** Contractor must agree to provide at least one continuing education session per year to center personnel as required at each of the following health centers or through the Virginia Association of Community Health Centers (VCHA). Contractor shall agree to pay all costs for personnel providing the education.

- 13. <u>Test Reporting</u>: Contractor must agree to provide at least the following information on a test report: laboratory identification; date collected; date received; patient name, identification number, patient date of birth, patient home and/or cell telephone number; ordering physician name; center site or account number; test name and number; expected normal value; actual value; and highlighted results which are out of range. <u>A sample test report should be attached to bid proposal.</u> Contractor's proposal should also state how any indication of mishandling of a specimen will be handled and reported to each center. Contractor must agree to provide no partial reports unless requested to do so by centers. Contractor must provide normal pediatric and adult ranges for each test.
- **Phlebotomists and Laboratory Consultants:** Contractor must state the availability of providing on-site phlebotomists and laboratory consultants; costs, if any, associated to particular health centers; and parameters for determining the number, location, and capacity of these service providers.

15. Electronic Medical Records:

- a. Contractor must ensure and provide bi-directional interfaces for integrating with the centers' electronic medical record system for ordering, billing and data management purposes. The interface must be tested and installed at the vendor's expense.
- b. Contractor will be responsible for working directly with third-party electronic medical record system vendors.
- c. All relevant information, including test results, to and from center's EHR system and centers' affiliated Health Center Control Network and state Health Information Exchanges (HIE) should be explained in the RFP response, as well as how Contractor would prioritize an EHR system change at health centers as it relates to re-mapping EHR to contractor databases.
- d. All systems and interfaces must be Health Level Seven (HL7) compliant.
- e. Contractor must describe any current interfaces or other initiatives involving health information exchange at either the local, community, regional, state or national levels. Include details describing payment responsibilities.
- f. Electronic lab results must be delivered in structured data field format and all labs associated with LOINC codes.

- g. Training related to the utilization of the interface shall be the vendor's responsibility and provided on-site to each health center.
- h. The vendor agrees to deliver any functionality necessary to meet patient-centered medical home ("PCMH") standards as published by the Joint Commission, the National Committee on Quality Assurance ("NCQA") or any other PCMH designating body, as well as any meaningful use requirements.

16. Value Add Services

Laboratory data is increasingly becoming a relied-upon source to evaluate clinical outcomes and assist in benchmarking for quality improvement initiatives. For this reason, Contractor should demonstrate the ability to offer analytics reports and dashboards that highlight utilizing lab services in a more efficient manner (lab stewardship), identify patients having multiple chronic conditions (basic risk stratification), and identify laboratory gaps in care. Applicants should also be able to address any partnerships that assist in case/care management.

- 17. Quarterly Summaries: Contractor must agree to meet with and provide VCHA quarterly the following information: The name and total number of tests performed by all centers, listed individually by name and location; the method of payment for the test; whether the test was paid for by the center or commercial insurance or the Medicaid or Medicare carrier; the total dollar volume billed by test; and, the frequency of each test from high to low. Contractor must also agree to meet regularly with the health center and provide a report containing the same information to each center by site.
- **18.** Administration Fee: VCHA is seeking a GPO arrangement pursuant to the appropriate safe harbor requirements. As such, Contractor will pay to the VCHA corporate office a flat administrative fee in an amount equal to lesser of 5% or the maximum amount permitted under the applicable law. Such administrative fees will be paid quarterly and will be supported by the quarterly reports (defined in #18 Quarterly Summaries.)
- 19. <u>Electronic Printers:</u> At no additional charge, Contractor must agree to locate and maintain printers strategically to handle the reporting needs of each center. The location of printer sites will be based on need, geographic location, and centers that had printers before the contract's inception. At least one printer will be placed with each center organization. Every effort will be made to ensure that all centers receive timely reporting. Printers will be used only to receive laboratory reports.
- **20. Supplies**: Contractor shall provide all supplies necessary for collecting specimens and any specialized containers at no additional charge, including any specific supplies for special

- population's collections. Center will agree to use supplies only for the collection of specimens referred to Contractor.
- **21.** <u>Invoices:</u> Contractor must agree that invoices submitted to each center shall be center-site specific, and shall include test name and number, patient's name and/or number, patient's date-of-birth, order date, price, and total cost of testing for the time period.
- **Indemnification:** Contractor shall furnish Proof of Insurance to cover its operations and must agree to indemnify a center for any loss which is the result of an act or omission by Contractor. Such insurance must be in the amount of at least \$500,000 per person and \$1,000,000 per incident.
- **23.** <u>Sub-Contracts</u>: Contractor must agree not to sub-contract any work under this contract without prior approval from VCHA.
- **24. Non-Discrimination Clause:** Contractor must agree to include in its contracts a non-discrimination clause.
- 25. Retention of Records: Contractor must agree to make all documents relating to this contract available to the Secretary of Health and Human Services or the Comptroller General or their duly authorized representatives up to four years after rendering of services pursuant to the requirements of Public Law 96-499, Section 952 (Paragraph 1861 (v)(1) of the Social Security Act). Cytology records must be retained for 10 years after rendering of services pursuant to the requirements of The College of American Pathologists.

Deliverables & Target Schedule

- 1. Complete the Bidders Information Sheet (Attachment #1).
- 2. Mark the lowest net price from your company for each test listed on Test List (Attachment #2)
- 3. Specify the CPT code for services bid.
- 4. Provide response to all Contract Specifications (or explain why unable to respond to individual specs).
- 5. Submit the bid via email (<u>kelliott@vcha.org</u>) to Kyle Elliott, VCHA Chief Legal Officer and General Counsel, on or before July 7, 2023.
- 6. Bid processing will begin on <u>June 1, 2023</u>. Bid awards will be made on or about <u>August 1, 2023</u>. Successful bidder will be notified in writing.
- 7. On a separate page of the submission, provide the process information necessary for a new FQHC member to be accepted under the contract. If an application is necessary, provide a copy of the application to be submitted.
- 8. Enclose a complete list of representatives for each respective region along with contact information.

Evaluation Metrics

In addition to price, the contract will be awarded on a variety of factors, including the ability to meet the stated criteria, the ability to provide services to all centers at the same level, the quality of educational materials and programs offered by the bidder and other regularly offered services. The contract will be for [three (3) period, commencing on September 1, 2023 and ending on August 30, 2026, and may be extended for up to three (3) additional individual years.

VCHA may make such reasonable investigations as deemed proper and necessary to determine the ability of the Contractor to perform the services/furnish the goods, and the Contractor shall provide any and all information or data for this purpose as may be requested. VCHA reserves the right to reject any proposal if the evidence submitted by, or investigations of, such Contractor fails to satisfy VCHA's standards that such Contractor is appropriately qualified to carry out the obligations of the contract and to provide the services and furnish the goods contemplated therein.

REFERENCES:

Contractors shall provide a list of at least three business references other than VCHA or its community members, where similar goods or services have been provided. Each reference shall include the name of the organization, the complete mailing address, the name of the contact person, their telephone number, and their email address.

QUESTIONS BIDDERS MUST ANSWER TO BE CONSIDERED:

Q: Is it possible to obtain the CPT codes for the test so that we can ensure we are looking at the correct test? What tests do each of the LPCA member facilities perform on-site?

Due to the time limits of the RFP set for contract selection and execution, we would ask
you to please provide responses to the requested components as best you can, based on
your existing experiences working with Federally Qualified Health Centers and
independent general practitioners in relation to the highest number of specific testing
your organization provides on an annual basis to primary care providers.

Q: What is the complexity level for each of the LPCA member facility laboratories? The four levels of test complexity are categorized as waived, low- provider-performed microscopy (PPM), moderate, and high.

- Most of the FQHC's are CLIA waived (estimated at 78%)
- Low Complexity (estimated at 18%)
- During the height of the COVID-19 Pandemic, we did have a few that moved to a Moderate Complexity (estimated at 2%)

• High Complexity are those that are attached to Hospital Systems (estimated at 2%)

 Upon staffing changes of staff handling specimens and/or billing, Contractor will supply additional training as requested by a particular center, either in person or virtually.

Q. Please advise if award will be made to a single source or will there be multiple awardees?

 The intent of the RFP is to review single source awardee capable of best-fulfilling needs of member health centers.
